We're off to a flying start in 2019 and I'd like to share some of the highlights of the past 3 months with you.

As we've done in the latter part of 2018, we continue to add talent across the organization including key leadership roles. Some of these are new management positions that have been added to the branch system as well as in our Marketing, Community Development, and Training areas.

In addition, we continue our practice of promoting from within to give current staff opportunities to develop and grow as the credit union grows. We're proud to help people move up in the organization and are delighted to bring their energy and new ideas into more responsible managerial roles in many cases.

We've also executed several projects designed to improve member service through technology and through our branch network to allow easier and more convenient access to the credit union 24/7 from wherever you are. These improvements included the roll out of a new account opening system in March to make it easier and quicker to join the

credit union. We moved our longstanding Wishart branch to Haygood, a newer

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more visible location in mid-January where we cut the ceremonial ribbon alongside Bobby Dyer, Mayor of Virginia Beach. We also achieved a milestone by opening our first Peninsula branch on George Washington Highway in Yorktown on March 4th and have a major grand opening celebration planned for early

April. This Yorktown branch will be the first of its kind for ABNB and will serve as a working model for the credit union's new "Total Financial Center" branch concept. Beyond traditional transactions-based products and services, we will also spotlight Business Services, Investment Services, Indirect Auto Lending, Home Loan Services and Insurance Services, all under one roof. We encourage all our Peninsula members to stop in to visit with our staff.

We continue to be deeply involved in the communities we serve in many ways. We're reaching out to both businesses and residents near our branches to expand our awareness and gain new members for the credit union. I am particularly proud of the efforts we made to assist members impacted by the government shutdown. Beyond offering a special Skip A Pay program and 0% interest short term loans for many members, we donated \$5,000 each to the Chief Petty Officers Associations of the Coast Guard Hampton Roads and Elizabeth City Chapters to assist local USCG families.
